



RULES AND POLICIES

Below is a list of Rules and Policies set forth by the Jewish Community Center of Greater Pittsburgh (JCC) and Emma Kaufmann Camp (JCC FACILITY). Please use this page to give to all participants and staff of your User so that they are aware of the Rules and Policies. The Facility User and its Members agree to abide by all rules and policies established by JCC FACILITY and the JCC from time to time regarding use of the Camp, including without limitation, those rules and policies stated in the Rules and Policies document attached. The Facility User agrees that any member of the User who fails to abide by such rules and policies, or who violates generally accepted standards of behavior, will be required to leave the camp immediately.

- Possession or use of illegal substances or prescription drugs without a prescription is prohibited. Any person in violation of this policy will be immediately required to leave JCC FACILITY.
- **JCC FACILITY** Any person found intoxicated to the point of being disruptive, detrimental, or dangerous to people and/or property is subject to expulsion with forfeiture of any fees paid by that person.
- JCC FACILITY is a nonsmoking facility, except for the porch behind the Counselor's Lounge. Any violation of this policy may result in a requirement to leave JCC FACILITY.
- There are no on-site medical facilities at the Camp. The User is responsible for the medical care of any Members in the User.
- JCC FACILITY is a kosher facility; no food items may be brought into dining hall or any housing areas. Members must keep any food items they bring in their cars and only used outside of camp.
- No pets are permitted at camp except for working animals.
- No persons may enter any building or area not available for their use. These areas will be discussed during the rental orientation.
- No visitation is permitted during a stay at camp by unregistered individuals.
- All vehicles must be kept in the camp's designated parking areas.
- Gambling is not permitted at camp.
- All Lake and Pool areas are off limits unless staffed and opened by Emma Kaufmann Camp personnel.
- Camp Fires on the property must be approved by JCC FACILITY Administrative Staff.
- JCC FACILITY is not responsible for the damage or loss of any personal belongings.

Waiver and Limitation of Liability: Members of the User are not obligated to participate in any activity available at the Camp. Sports and similar physical activities intrinsically involve risk of physical injury greater than that encountered in daily life. Those Members of the User executing this Agreement represent that they and all other Members of the User are aware that participating in such sports and activities involves such risk and that all such Members who participate do so at their own risk and will exercise the necessary care and caution having due regard for the nature of the sport or activity, the terrain, location, climate, co-participants, or other circumstances. Those Members signing this agreement on behalf of themselves and all other Members of the User hereby acknowledge that neither the JCC nor any employee, officer, or director of the JCC shall be liable for any injury, illness, or property damage resulting from any such Member's participation in such sports or activities or use of any other facility at the Camp.
